Akama Shrine

Emperor Antoku, defeated in the Battle of Dan-no-ura and drowned in the Kanmon Straits at the young age of 8, is enshrined here. On the grounds of the temple, you will find the Hoichi Hall from Lafcadio Hearn's famous Hoichi the Earless.

Statue of Shinsaku Takasugi

Shinsaku Takasugi was a patriot and part of the driving force behind the Meiji Restoration. He raised Japan's first militia in Kozanji Temple, organizing them to challenge the Tokugawa Shogunate.

Nagato

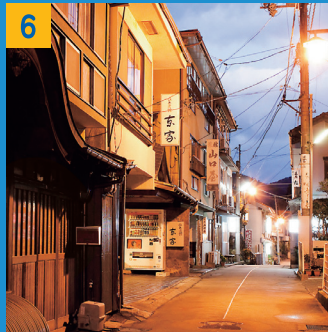

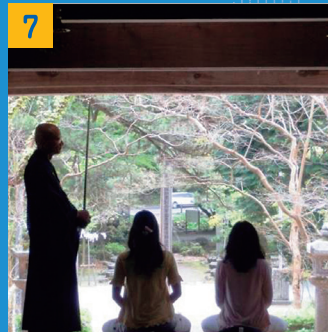

Tokiwa Park

The Ube Biennale (International Sculpture Competition) is held in Tokiwa Park once every two years. This international competition has a history of more than a half-century and is one of the largest outdoor sculpture exhibitions in Japan, with entries from countries around the world. Visitors can enjoy a dynamic exhibition of contemporary sculptures and models.

Fujigochi Tea Plantation (Ono Tea)

The spectacular view of one of Japan's largest tea plantations spreads across over 70 hectares of small hills. There is a gift shop approximately 10 minutes from the tea garden by car that also offers tours of the tea factory and tea picking experiences. With a perfect mix of sharpness and bitterness, Ono Tea is great tea to bring home or to give as a gift, and is loved as one of Yamaguchi's specialties.
